2005-06 HOLY ROSARY CHILDREN'S CHOIR. \*TUESDAY\* PRACTICES THIS YEAR. Who will lead the music in church when we\_re all much older? How will they know what to do? What songs will they sing? The Holy Rosary Children\_s Choir is an integral part of our parish music ministry, helping our school and parish students learn how to lead the music at mass. What they learn as children will provide them a solid foundation as they grow to become our future music ministry leaders! Students in grades 2-8 are eligible to participate (reading age). Practices are on TUESDAY from 3:15-4:15, beginning October 11, 2005 and going through May 9, 2006. The Children\_s Choir sings at a parish mass about once a month, including Christmas and Easter! Older students learn how to cantor and sing harmony! Parents can help out and earn school volunteer hours. Choir try-outs and orientation will be Tuesday, October 4 at 3:15 in the church. If you have some outgrown uniforms in great condition that you would like to pass on, please have your child drop them off in the patrol room. We'll pick up from there!

SCRIP SALES. Thank you to the 26 families that took advantage of our bi-weekly SCRIP FCE order form and purchased \$4,900.00 worth of grocery gift certificates – that's \$245 profit for our school!!! Our next bi-weekly FCE SCRIP processing day is Monday, October 17<sup>th</sup>. Please remember - All orders MUST be turned into the school office by 9:00am, Monday to be processed that day. Our SCRIP office team only processes on Mondays, every other week – this is the only time that we are in the SCRIP office and/or check the SCRIP box in the school office. If your order comes in after 9:00am on the processing Monday, we will either send your UNprocessed order back to you in that week's FCE or hold onto it until the following process day – just depends when we happen to stop by the school office. Please remember, all other SCRIP purchases are made thru our Daily/Sunday sales table – please do not send the Daily/Sunday order form thru the school office – these purchases must go thru the SCRIP sales table. The SCRIP Daily/Sunday sales hours are M-F, 8:00-8:45am in the school hall entrance or after mass on Sundays when there is coffee & donuts scheduled.

**eScrip.** Have you registered your Safeway Club card yet? If so, how about your family/friends/neighbors/co-workers? It's very easy. To register, go to <a href="www.escrip.com">www.escrip.com</a>. Make sure you use our school's ID #8563292. Once registered, your purchases will be tracked thru eScrip and our school will earn up to 8% of your purchases!!! You can even use your favorite credit card for payment (though we would LOVE IT if you would purchase gift cards thru SCRIP – an extra 5% for our school!).

LAST CALL - SAFEWAY 10% BACK TO SCHOOLS. If you still have a Rewards Certificate to turn in, PLEASE DO SO BY FRIDAY, October 7<sup>th</sup>. If you are enrolled in eScrip, all purchases thru 9/6 of participating products marked with a yellow school bus will be automatically donated to your school. If you are NOT ENROLLED IN eSCRIP, check your receipt the first time you shop at Safeway after September 6<sup>th</sup>. It will have a Rewards Certificate on the back with a Redemption Code and your total contribution amount. We need to log these certificates in by October 11<sup>th</sup>. Thanks to everyone who has already sent theirs in – we're hoping for some big \$\$\$ for HRS. We'll report to you next week how much \$\$\$ was turned in.
