Classroom Advent wreaths will be blessed tomorrow morning at our 8:30AM Prayer Service, which will be led by the students in grade 5A. If you would like to have a family Advent wreath blessed, please place it on the table that will be in front of the stage. Immediately following the Prayer Service, students will report to their Faith Families to exchange names for their Advent Prayer Partner. Tomorrow your child will be bringing home a note with the name of his/her Prayer Partner and the directions for making a card and writing a prayer. Please keep this information in a safe place. Please read the directions carefully, noting that it's important for every student to MAKE a special Christmas card with a prayer message for his/ her Prayer Partner. Students will turn their cards and prayers into their homeroom teacher on Monday, Dec. 19. Card stock paper will be given to the students for these special Christmas cards.

**THE FEAST OF THE IMMACULATE CONCEPTION** is Thursday, Dec. 8. Students will gather at 8:45AM to celebrate Mass. Perfect uniforms, including the uniform sweater, vest or sweatshirt are required.
