After you carefully review your child's report card, please sign the envelope and send it back to school. Signed envelopes need to be returned by Friday, December 16. If you have a question or concern regarding your child's academic or behavioral progress, please email or phone the appropriate teacher. I have reviewed all report cards and I am very proud of our students' achievements and dedication to their school work. I am also proud of and grateful for the commitment of our excellent teaching staff. Thank you for your continued involvement and interest in your child's education. Research clearly shows that the most successful schools are the ones where teachers, parents and students work closely together. Holy Rosary School certainly fits that model.

CHRISTMAS PROGRAMS. Please plan ahead for the Holy Rosary School Christmas programs. There are many factors that have led us to this decision. It started with Safeway pulling their gift card program at the beginning of summer. Sixty-five percent of our profits came from our Safeway sales. We have been purchasing most of our national Scrip from Scrip Advantage who we recently learned are having money problems. There ARE other Scrip centers that we can work with, but without Safeway, we are finding it is not Holy Rosary School's best use of our volunteer hours.
