ARCHDIOCESAN MANDATORY BACKGROUND CHECK FOR ALL SCHOOL VOLUNTEERS

All volunteers who have regular, ongoing, and UNSUPERVISED access to minors and/or vulnerable adults must have a cleared CICS criminal background check. Some examples of volunteers to whom this applies: all coaches and assistance coaches, Boy Scout/Girl Scout leaders, parent volunteers in the school office and health room, playground volunteers, all parents or guardians driving on field trips (CICS checks driving records), anyone with access to money or goods, including fundraisers, auction procurement volunteers, etc. Parents who are helping in a classroom under the supervision of a teacher are NOT required to have a background check. We are including the form in each FCE. If you need more than one form, copies are available in the school office.
