TRAFFIC FLOW ALERT. During drop off and pick up when the traffic flow stops because people are not following the rules, unsafe things happen. Thank you to those who do comply and everyone else, please do. Follow the rules for the safety of our children. **Problem Areas**: When dropping off or picking up your student(s) please visualize two lanes going north on 42nd in front of the school. The curb lane - use your blinker into the curb lane and out from the curb lane, all the way out to the middle of 42nd street. If half of your car is at the curb and half of your car is in the middle of the street others cannot proceed and we have backups. Please look for Tony D. and Safety Patrol students – if the patrol students have their stop flags follow his directions. extended please STOP your car, do not proceed through the circle, even if you think you are going to miss them. It is not okay to proceed and it is unsafe. There have been many reports of this happening. **Parking** – People are parking too close to the intersections. The patrol students cannot see around these cars and it creates an unsafe situation. You should be at least 30 feet from the intersections for safety's sake and it is the law.
