LENTEN SEASON AT HOLY ROSARY SCHOOL. Lent is an excellent time to remember that yes, indeed, Jesus is the reason for our school. Tomorrow morning's prayer service, led by Ms. Semandiris and the students in 5A, will be focused around the three ways we observe Lent: daily prayer, fasting, and almsgiving. In preparation for Ash Wednesday Mass at 8:45 on March 1, students will be asked to write their personal goals for Lent. Students will receive individual rice bowls at school. Please encourage your children to contribute to their rice bowls each week and add their coins to the parish rice bowl collection at Sunday Mass. We are encouraging our students and their families to give up desserts every Thursday, and on Fridays, every family is invited to bring in one extra brown bag lunch and a small item for the St. Martin de Porres Men's shelter. Next Friday, March 3, the small item is men's socks. During Lent, daily Mass at Holy Rosary begins at 7:45AM making it possible for students to attend and still arrive on time for school. In order to receive registration papers and ensure your child(ren)'s enrollment for next year, you must be current with tuition payments and tithing obligations.
