We have saved well over 1500 items from our landfills since we started the program in December 2004. In less than 2 years, we have earned a total of \$3150. This program has become a success because of your involvement. Thank you to all who participated this year by turning in their old printer cartridge and cell phones. Especially, those who involved their work place. A special thanks also to Peggy Cunningham who calls me when she is overwhelmed with printer cartridges in the school office.
