<u>WASL SCORES</u>. If your child attended 7<sup>th</sup> or 4<sup>th</sup> grade at Holy Rosary School last spring, you will find his/her WASL test results enclosed in this FCE. Students at HR were tested in the areas of reading, writing, and math, but not science. Please note that the eport identifies your child's score, the average scores of Holy Rosary School, the Archdiocese, and WA State. On the back is further information regarding your child's performance. Holy Rosary students as a whole, performed well above average in all three areas, with 100% of our 4<sup>th</sup> grade students meeting or exceeding the standards in both reading and writing.
