Last week I had the privilege of serving on an Accreditation Visiting Team at Assumption School in Bellingham. As always, I found the experience most rewarding and discovered a Catholic school quite similar to Holy Rosary, most especially in its strong faith community and Catholic identity, and commitment to high academic standards. On Monday the principal of Assumption St. Bridget School, Mike Foy, very suddenly passed away. Mike had served as principal at Assumption St. Bridget for 19 years. He was an excellent Catholic educator and leader, and was highly regarded, not only at Assumption, but by his colleagues in the Archdiocese. The Vigil Service for him will be Friday evening, Nov. 10, at St. Bridget's Church at 7:00 pm and the funeral will be on Saturday, Nov. 11, at 10:00 am at St. Joseph's Church. I know that you will keep Mike, his family, and the Assumption community in your prayers at this difficult and sad time.

Beginning in July 2006, families in the school who are registered in our parish, and thus receive in-parish tuition, are asked to tithe a minimum of \$840.00 a year, which is about \$16.00 each Sunday. This is the first increase in the minimum tithing commitment in 25 years. 2.) In order to receive in-parish registration, school families must complete a new stewardship commitment card each fall.
