ST. JUDE HOSPITAL MATHATHON During this Lenten season, students have the opportunity to share their time, treasure and talent by participating in the St. Jude Children's Hospital Mathathon. Students answer approximately 200 math problems; then, find sponsors willing to pledge some amount of money for each correctly answered problem. St. Jude is the only pediatric cancer research center where families never pay for treatments that are not covered by insurance, and families without insurance are never asked to pay. 78 students have returned a registration form to participate in the St. Jude Mathathon. A second order for books and CD-ROMs will be placed on Monday. If your child would like to participate, please return the permission/registration by that time.

THE PASSION ACCORDING TO LUKE PERFORMANCE will be held Thursday, March 22nd at 1:00 pm in the Church. SAFETY FIRST-TRAFFIC FLOW. Last week's FCE had a "gentle" reminder about safety in our drop off and pick up zone.
