GREEN TIP FOR OCT 16 4 million plastic water bottles are used each DAY in Washington State. 80% of those are not recycled. Each one takes 1,000 years to biodegrade. 25% of bottled water is simply reprocessed municipal/city water. The average energy cost to make the plastic, fill the bottle, transport it to market and then deal with the waste is the equivalent of "filling up a quarter of every bottle with oil." (Peter Gleick, water policy expert.) So, make a move toward waste free lunches by eliminating those plastic water bottles and replacing them with reusable ones. Stainless steel water bottles are available at the PCC and many other local stores, and on-line at KleanKanteen.com. Other sites of interest: GreenHalloween.org and WasteFreeLunches.org. Remember that Fridays are still Green Fridays! Carpools, bikes, walking, bus; all alternative transportation modes are encouraged! Finally, all interested parents, teachers and parishioners are invited to attend the Green Team meeting on Wednesday, October 29, at 7 pm in the School Hall. Hope to see you there!
