The state requires no less that 175 days and a minimum of 1000 instructional hours. We are right at 175 days and we have 1020 instructional hours. Let's hope for no more missed school!

Note: W-2 forms are not acceptable. Do not send originals. 2) Make a copy of any documents related to Non-Taxable income (Child Support, Welfare, Social Security) and any additional 2007 Federal Tax Schedules A-F and 1099, if applicable. 3) Enter online all the data requested in the application form. When completed, press Submit to send the data. 4) Print two copies of the completed form, this can be done immediately after submitting the form. 5) Sign the form in Part E. 6) Staple the signed application in front of copies of the financial documents from step 2 and 3. 7) Deliver or mail the complete application package to Jennifer at Holy Rosary by February 13th.
