THE SEASON OF LENT BEGINS NEXT WEEK ON ASH WEDNESDAY, FEBRUARY 25, WITH OUR SCHOOL MASS AT 8:45AM. STUDENTS MUST BE IN PERFECT UNIFORMS FOR THIS MASS. THE SIXTH GRADE CLASSES ARE PLANNING THIS MASS. SCHOOL HAS CHOSEN "RETURN TO ME" AS OUR LENTEN THEME. STUDENTS WILL BE WRITING DOWN THEIR PERSONAL INTENTIONS ON A BOOMERANG AROUND THE THREE HALLMARKS OF LENT: PRAYER. FASTING. AND ALMSGIVING. PLEASE TAKE A MINUTE TO REFLECT WITH YOUR CHILDREN ON THEIR PERSONAL INTENTIONS. AS A SCHOOL, WE WILL BE OBSERVING LENT IN THE FOLLOWING WAYS: EACH CLASS WILL SIGN UP TO ATTEND THE 8:00AM MASS TOGETHER WITH THEIR TEACHER AT LEAST ONCE DURING LENT. PARENTS, OF COURSE, ARE INVITED TO ATTEND MASS WITH YOUR CHILD'S CLASS. ON THE WEDNESDAYS OF LENT WE ASK THE STUDENTS TO FAST FROM DESSERTS. ON FRIDAYS OF LENT FAMILIES ARE INVITED TO SEND IN ONE BROWN BAG LUNCH WITH AN EXTRA ITEM FOR THE MEN LIVING AT ST. MARTIN DE PORRES (SEE NOTICE IN THIS NEWSLETTER). AND ON MARCH 2 AND APRIL 1 WE ARE ENCOURAGING EACH CHILD TO CONTRIBUTE \$1.00 FOR THE UGANDAN CHILDREN THAT HOLY ROSARY SPONSORS.
