BE ON THE LOOKOUT FOR MATH-A-THONERS!! Students at HRS are participating in a Matha-thon raising money for the children at St. Jude Children's' Research Hospital. St. Jude Children's' Research Hospital is recognized for its pioneering work in finding cures and saving children with cancer and other catastrophic diseases. Founded by late entertainer Danny Thomas and based in Memphis, Tennessee, St. Jude freely shares its discoveries with scientific and medical communities around the world. No family ever pays for treatments not covered by insurance and families without insurance are never asked to pay. With their parents' permission, students complete the Funbook either online or in the paper version. Both formats contain more than 200 grade appropriate math problems. Students obtain sponsors willing to support them and St. Jude's Hospital. All donations are collected, returned to HRS and then forwarded to St. Jude's.
