The season of Lent begins on Ash Wednesday, February 17, with our school Mass at 8:45am. All students should come to school in perfect uniform. The sixth grade classes are planning this Mass. Our theme this year is "God says 'Return to me with all your heart!' In other words, 'Come in out of the cold and warm up!' ". Please take a few minutes to reflect with your children on the three hallmarks of Lent: **PRAYER, FASTING AND ALMSGIVING**, as well as their own personal intentions. Classes will be participating in individual class Masses during Lent. On Fridays of Lent families are invited to send in one brown bag lunch with an extra item for the men living at St. Martin de Porres (see notice in this newsletter). Watch for additional information on both school and Parish Lenten activities in future newsletters and the Parish bulletin.

Please remember to check the calendar on-line for all February activities. Remember there will be **no school** on **Friday, February 12**, which is the day off for meeting our goal in the magazine sale. School will also be **out** on **Monday, February 15th** and **Tuesday, February 16th** for Winter Break. Planning ahead, please note that in March there will be no school for kindergarten students due to prospective kindergarten student testing on March 5th. BASE is open that day for current Kindergartners, with a \$40 fee for the full day. There will be no school for on Friday March 19th due to a staff professional development meeting.

BROWN BAG FRIDAYS FOR ST. MARTIN de PORRES SHELTER DURING LENT will begin Friday, February 19. You are invited to include a pair of socks with the lunch on the 19th. Study Hall sign up is now online. This is a free service and requires a minimal amount of time for sign-up.

- 1. Please enter http://<u>hrstudyhall2.eventbrite.com</u> in your browser. The password is "gators" (all lowercase).
- 2. You will create a username and password the <u>first time</u> you register on EventBrite for Study Hall.
- 3. Select the quantity of "tickets" you need per date. (one per attending child).
- 4. Select the date your child/ren will attend. <u>Tickets are available seven days before the event</u> and end three hours before the event. Tickets are limited to 30 due to space in the library. Each date requires a separate transaction and ticket. If the maximum amount of students has been reached, or if tickets are requested more than seven days before the event, a message will read "The quantity of tickets you have requested is not available."
- 5. You will receive a confirmation email with a ticket/s. You <u>WILL NOT</u> have to print the ticket. A master list is created and attendance will be taken at study hall. <u>We are not able to</u> <u>accommodate students who are not scheduled in advance for study hall</u>.
