During the month of February we are focusing on the construct of Social Cognition which is the way we use words and actions to get along with others. For Preschool, Kindergarten and Grade One this could mean the need to emerge from parallel play, compliance with adult supervision in play, and/or the initial challenge of sharing and conflict resolution. For grades 1-3 it's the need to appreciate the perspectives of others, the requirement of recognizing the two-way nature of relationships, and/or a demand for reciprocity (giving and taking). For grades 4-8 it is a quest for intimacy in friendship, the need for conscious reputation building, and/or the emergence of varying degrees of friendship. Please come check out our new AKOM bulletin board outside the faculty lounge and ask your children about AKOM lessons taught in the classroom.

# Tuition Assistance Applications for the 2011-12 School Year are due Friday,

**February 4<sup>th</sup>.** The application is available on-line at http://fulcrumfoundation.org/tuition (A link to the application is on the school website under 'School Forms & Other Downloads'.) Please follow these instructions and note that in addition to submitting an application on-line to Fulcrum, paper copies of the completed application must be delivered to Jennifer at Holy Rosary School by **February 4th**:

- 1. Make a copy of your 2009 Federal Income Tax Form(s), IRS 1040, 1040A or 1040EZ, or Efile printout for the financially responsible parent(s) or guardian(s). Note: W-2 forms are not acceptable. Do not send originals.
- 2. Make a copy of any documents related to Non-Taxable income (Part C-3) such as 1099, federal or state aid, alimony or child support.
- 3. Submit your application form \*online at http://fulcrumfoundation.org/tuition At the end of the submission process a printout will be produced. If you have made a mistake, submit a new application and destroy the incorrect printout. When entering names, please do not use ALL CAPS.
- 4. Print two copies of the completed form. This can be done immediately after submitting the form. Be sure to sign your tax forms. This is often overlooked, especially with E-filing. Fulcrum will not accept un-signed forms.
- 5. Sign the form in Part E.
- 6. Staple the signed application in front of copies of the financial documents from steps 1 and 2.
- 7. Deliver or mail the complete application package to Jennifer at Holy Rosary by February 4th. Copies will not be returned.

February - Ordinary Time - the liturgical color is green which symbolizes growth, hope, and life. February 3rd is the Feast of St. Blaise, who was a good bishop. We only know about St. Blaise through stories. Some stories say that he was a doctor, while others say that he lived by himself, and that he cured and tamed wild animals. What seems to be the same in all the stories about Blaise is that he lived during a time when many leaders did not want people to be Christians, and that he died because of his faith in Jesus. One of the most famous traditional stories about St. Blaise is that he cured a young boy who was choking on a fish bone. In the sixteenth century a custom arose from this story, the blessing of throats on the feast of St. Blaise, by tying an unlit candle into the shape of a cross and blessing someone's throat.

Activity: Blaise Blessings

After sharing the story about St. Blaise with your child, then place your hand on the child's shoulder, and say a simple prayer: "St. Blaise, please ask God to watch over (NAME) in this season of colds and sore throats. Amen."
