## **GATOR GEAR INFORMATION**

The 7th/8th grade Leadership elective kids give the "Gator Gear" to your oldest child's classroom teacher. Your child is responsible to bring it home.

March - Lent – the liturgical color is violet/purple which symbolizes penance and sacrifice

March 17 – St. Patrick

St. Patrick, a patron saint of Ireland, was born in Britain. Forced to go to Ireland as a slave at the age of 16, he took care of sheep and was very lonely. During his time alone he prayed to God often and felt God's strong love. He later escaped and went back to Britain. He studied to become a priest and a teacher so that he could go back to Ireland and teach about Jesus. He became such an inspirational teacher that almost all of the people in Ireland became Christian.
