#### **Mustard Seed Corner – April 21**

This section of the EFC is written by HR Parish Faith Formation staff and is specially created to present information, inspiration, and education on different aspects of Catholic Tradition. (It is not Imprimi Potest, Nihil Obstat, or Imprimatur.)

Liturgical Color - During Lent we use Purple for the priest's vestments and various parts of the Church to symbolize Penance and Sacrifice.

And entering the tomb, they saw a young man sitting on the right side, dressed in a white robe; and they were amazed. And he said to them, "Do not be amazed; you seek Jesus of Nazareth, who was crucified. He has risen, he is not here; see the place where they laid him. But go, tell his disciples and Peter that he is going before you to Galilee; there you will see him, as he told you." Mark 16:5-7

Easter is the highest and holiest of days for all Christians. It is a day we celebrate the new life we have in Jesus, Son of God, who died and three days later rose from the dead. The gift of hope and life after death is the eternal message of the day. What a sacrifice Jesus made for each and everyone of us!

Scholars and historians have different ideas about where the word Easter came from. Some say that it comes from the English word "Eastre" which was the name of the pagan goddess of spring and new life. Others say it comes from the German word "eostarun," which means dawn. Dawn would relate to the time of day Jesus rose from the dead. Still

others believe that the word Easter comes from the Latin word "albae," which means dawn and white. White is the color of purity and the color of the clothes that the newly baptized wore on Easter. Look for our newly baptized in church wearing white robes. The special term for newly baptized is "neophytes."
