Dear Parents,

In Wednesday's Gospel, we encounter a story that begins with a description of a scene in which John is standing around with two of his friends when Jesus passes by. The two friends apparently do not recognize Jesus, but we find out that they have heard of Him. As they watched Jesus, John states: "Behold the Lamb of God". Once they heard this, they headed after Him. I love the next part-Jesus suddenly turns and asks, "What are you looking for?" It is a great question, one I think that needed to be asked, and a question we all can ask ourselves. But I want to ask it rhetorically with regard to the school and then try to answer it. See if you agree.

As parents, what are we looking for in a school, for our children, for us as parents? On my list, a safe environment comes first. By this, I include not only a school that practices their fire drills, provides for health emergencies, watches out for intruders, etc. but also a school in which the children feel they are in a warm and supporting place and one in which the teachers care about them. Our Church takes a view that each human person is a reflection of God and from that premise follows the basis of our efforts as educators and parents. So, when we teach, we do so because it uplifts, when we praise, we do so because it uplifts and even when we correct a child, we do so because ultimately it uplifts.

As parents, along with a suitable environment, we seek excellent instruction from qualified and caring instructors. In a Catholic School, I think we all wish to see in our teachers, women and men that witness their faith in action. This allows the children to

witness first hand what it means to give service to others. Teachers can be such wonderful examples of this; Catholic School teachers take to an even higher level. I think parents are also looking for community. Every excellent school I know of has this quality to a high degree.

Father Edwin McDermott, SJ was a wonderful professor at the University of San Francisco who wrote about the three distinctive qualities of a Catholic School, and they incorporate, Message, Community and Service. As I see it, though we need to always keep striving to improve, Holy Rosary School incorporates these to a high degree, and that is why our school is as special as it is!

All boys and girls ages 10 to 14 are invited to participate in the local level of competition for the 2012 Knights of Columbus Free Throw Championship. The local competition will be held Saturday, January 21st at 3:30 PM, at Holy Rosary School Gym (4142 42nd Ave. S.W.)

The Our Lady of Guadalupe Council and the Holy Rosary Round Table Knights of Columbus are sponsoring this community event. Each boy and girl age group champion will be eligible to advance to the District Competition to be held in February, followed by the State Competition. Participants are required to furnish proof of age (birth certificate, etc).

Please follow these instructions and note that in addition to submitting an application on-line to Fulcrum, paper copies of the completed application must be delivered to Thea at Holy Rosary School by February 6th:

Make a copy of your 2010 Federal Income Tax Form(s), IRS 1040, 1040A or 1040EZ, or E-file printout for the financially responsible parent(s) or guardian(s). Note: W-2 forms are not acceptable. Do not send originals.

Make a copy of any documents related to Non-Taxable income (Part C-3) such as 1099, federal or state aid, alimony or child support.

Submit your application form *online at

http://fulcrumfoundation.org/tuition At the end of the submission process a printout will be produced. If you have made a mistake, submit a new application and destroy the incorrect printout. When entering names, please do not use ALL CAPS.

Print two copies of the completed form. This can be done immediately after submitting the form. Be sure to sign your tax forms. This is often overlooked, especially with E-filing. Fulcrum will not accept un-signed forms.

Sign the form in Part E.

Staple the signed application in front of copies of the financial documents from steps 1 and 2.

Deliver or mail the complete application package to Thea at Holy Rosary by February 6th. Copies will not be returned.

*Fulcrum will not be accepting handwritten applications. If you would like to submit a handwritten application, please ask Thea De Francesco to assist you. She may be contacted at (206) 937-1488, ext. 211 or email: tdefrancesco@holyrosaryseattle.org

The bishop will be here Monday evening, April 30th @ 7pm to confer the sacrament of confirmation. If you are a Catholic adult over the age of 18 who has not yet been confirmed, we will offer a series of sessions beginning February 1st at 7pm in the Parish Center to prepare you for this sacrament. A Catholic is fully initiated into the church with the sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist. We are inviting any adult Catholic who has not yet been confirmed to prayerfully consider joining us for the preparation and the reception of this sacrament. You may give me a call at 206-937-1488, Ext. 203, to register and/or for any questions you may have. There is an adult confirmation form on our website for you to complete and return to me. Please note that these sessions are for practicing Catholics. If you were baptized Catholic and never raised in the faith and now want to practice your faith or baptized in another Christian faith tradition and now want to become Catholic, we invite you into our RCIA process.
