Back to School Coffee for all parents will be hosted by Parents Club on Tuesday, September 4th, the first day of school. Please stop by the school hall starting at 8:15 for coffee and conversation.

First Week of School Schedule: The first day of school is Tuesday, Sept. 4th. Dismissal is at noon for grades 1-8 and at 10:00am for Kindergarten. On Wednesday, Sept. 5th school dismisses at 2:15pm for grades 1-8 and noon for Kindergarten. On Thursday, Sept. 6th Grades 1-8 will dismiss at 3:00pm and Kindergarten will dismiss at noon. Friday, Sept. 7th is a noon dismissal for everyone.

Professional Development For Staff: School dismisses at 2:15 p.m. **every** Wednesday for staff meetings and professional development.

Drop-off/Pick- up: We ask that you observe the following for everyone's safety and convenience. Please DO NOT EVER park along 42nd Avenue in front of the school during morning drop off between 8am – 8:30am. Drivers should never leave their vehicles when dropping off in front of the school or in the alley. Please use the crosswalks. If the traffic manager directs you please follow the instructions immediately. Also please remember that the HEART Auction parking spot is always reserved for the family who purchased it; please do not park in or block that space at any time.

Background Checks: All volunteers must also have a background check completed within the last three years and on-file in the parish office.

Immunizations: If you have a child entering Kindergarten or 6th grade, please send in the correct immunization forms indicating they are current with their vaccinations. Washington State law requires that all schools keep accurate immunization records on all students. **Forms are Due the first day of school.**

Medication Policy: Washington State Law requires In order to dispense medication, including albuterol inhalers, EpiPens, etc to your child the office must have an oral medication/prescription permission form authorized by a Licensed Healthcare Provider, who has prescribed the medication and the parent/legal guardian.

The parent/guardian must also provide the medication, which is from a Licensed Healthcare Provider in its original labeled container from the pharmacy. The container must include the name of the student, medication, dosage information and enough medication to be administered at school. For non-prescription medications such as Aspirin, acetaminophen, and ibuprofen the school also needs an oral medication/prescription form signed by a health provider and parent. No Medication will be given to a child without an oral medication/prescription form on file.
