We will be graduating a class of 53 students this year. Exceptional results, that speak well of our overall program, our excellent teachers and staff as well as you, our parents and families!

Dear Families,

I started by sharing the results of our 8th Grade Catholic High School admissions results. I am so proud of these students, as all our faculty and staff are. I would like to point out that they are not only academically solid but have also displayed wonderful leadership qualities. The impressions that they formed with the interested applicant families at our Open House event three weeks ago continue a long history of positive results. I think that every family I interviewed commented on how impressed they were with our 8th Grade tour guides during Open House.

We have made great progress in shaping up our school over the last year. Thanks to the efforts of many in our community, we have a newly painted gym, new cubbies for the kindergarten, a new cubby for the 3rd grade, more fresh paint in the interior of the school including the school office and health room, a new tiled floor in the health room, new desks for the school offices, and we got the front of the school sidewalk project done! I want to share the latest improvement, which was accomplished through the generosity of one of the members of our school community together with some school funds. The school drinking fountains on the 2nd floor became a real function challenge for our plant manager, Mr. Scott Stoffen. Scott does a marvelous job keeping all the mechanical aspects of our school working, but Scott and the plumbers met their match with our old drinking fountains. Over the last six months, he would fix them, only to see them break again. I think what was happening was unintentional-when the kids filled their water bottles they were twisting the nozzles to align with the opening in their water bottle and snapping the internal fittings of the drinking fountain. We needed to replace them, but these were not in the budget. As Scott and I looked for a fix, I was approached by a wonderful person whose husband works for a company that ended up giving us a grant for top quality drinking fountains with a built in water bottle filler! I ordered them immediately and they were installed last Friday afternoon. Nintendo is the company that provided the funds. The person who works for the company wishes to remain anonymous. Thank you both!

Two more mentions this week:

I want to commend the Parent's Club for generating such participation this year-great work with the conversations and presentations that have been truly wonderful. Come to the Parent's Club meeting tomorrow night to see what all the excitement is about. I understand that the refreshments are a real part of the success! Last year, the Auction produced great results including raising significant funds for our tuition assistance fund. Those funds have made a vast difference to many of our families. This year, the appeal to help support those in need will once again be during the dessert auction, please earmark that appeal. Your generosity of time/treasure/talent has made a difference for many years-thank you.

This year's auction team has made great strides filling all the key roles and is planning and working busily behind the scenes. Our auction continues to be our most significant fund-raiser in our budget. If you are not already involved, now is the time to step up to make sure we have another great effort this year. Thanks to all of you already involved in all the aspects of the auction-as we know, it is for the worth of causes: the children of Holy Rosary School who all deserve our best effort!
