School Commission

The School Commission met on May 2nd for our last business meeting of the year. During the meeting, we recognized **Kaiti Grassley**, **Nicole Herdener**, **Marty Sumner-Johnson**, **Kamila Kennedy**, **Jodi Mass**, **Maura McCann**, **Marti McGaughey**, **Marcia Metcalf**, and **Molly Ward** for the incredible work they did as this year's auction chairs. As auction chairs, they put in many, many hours, both day and night, planning, preparing, organizing, and driving this year's auction. It was a fantastic evening and is a huge benefit to Holy Rosary as our biggest fundraiser. Thank you ladies for your dedication and support of HRS.

In addition, we approved the April meeting minutes which can be found *here* (http://www.holyrosaryws.org/forms/School_Commission_Minutes/2012-13/2013-04-11SchoolCommissionMinutes.pdf). Ann Summers presented the 3 new members of School Commission for next year: **Terry Burns, Brett Conway,** and **Christine Tobin-Presser**. Brett and Christine were able to join the meeting. We are thrilled to have such great new members for next year.

Finally, the School Commission passed four motions in support of the financial health of the school heading into next year. These include the following: 1) We approved a Centennial Campaign of \$2,000,000 that will include items such as replacing the Big Toy, replacing the school roof, completing the replacement of the school windows, and building the Fr. Mallahan Endowment Fund; 2) We approved to increase the target for the Annual Fund for the 2013-14 school year to \$200,000; 3) We approved that the

incoming interim principal, George Hofbauer, and/or others will meet with parents regarding a one year pledge to the Annual Fund, a three to five year pledge to the Centennial Campaign, and a reaffirmation of their pledge to the Parish (if they are parishioners); and 4) We approved that members of the School Commission will be first in line to meet with the interim principal to make these pledges.

Much more detailed information around these motions and how each family can participate will be coming over the next few months. The School Commission fully supports Mr. Hofbauer in formulating a strategic plan that will ensure the financial health of Holy Rosary School now and in the future. Once the plan is finalized, we look forward to helping communicate it and driving it to success. Thank you for your support of the School Commission and Holy Rosary School this year.
