This week our new SmartBoards are being installed and we are preparing the IPads that arrived for our third grade class rooms. Technology is growing at Holy Rosary. What the future holds in this area is very much up for discussion all over the country. Some Schools institute a BYOD (bring your own device) policy as education attempts to update and improve its interactions between students and technology in the great adventure of learning. Time will tell what the future holds, but we are called upon, in the meantime, to make wise decisions based upon present needs and realistic abilities.

Two families have asked me to look into the institution of a study hall as part of our BASE program. This would be more for grades 5-7. I think it would be for the hours of 4:00-6:00. If someone is in BASE it would be for free ----well what you are already paying ----- if someone is just interested in this the fee would be \$7 per hour. It would be for Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday of each week. The fee would have to be paid in advance for one month and non-refundable so we can work out a working schedule. It would be staffed by a present BASE employee, an eighth grader, or a staff member. It would be up to parents to help their children understand that this is an academic time during which homework, long term projects, or studying is being done. If you are interested in this please just email me with your name and the number of children you want involved. Or let Donna know. But please do it within the next ten days. I would need at least seven to make this work.

It was great to be honored with the presence of a number of the Dominican Sisters when we did the "Living Rosary" on Monday. They were moved as the children thanked and greeted them as they were leaving the Church. I look forward to our major celebration with them on Saturday October 26th at 1:00. I hope you can all come and celebrate with them and with our Archbishop.

I will "snail mail" the newsletter for October, along with the Annual Report for the School. I think you will find it of interest. If people do not feel like it is worth the time, effort, or cost I ask you to let me, or one of the Parents Club Officers or School Commission members know.

Centennial Time Capsule Ceremony Friday morning at 8:25 October 11th.

As a special centennial event, the 8th grade class is creating a time capsule with items special to the year 2013. We hope to blow the minds of the HRS community of 2063, 50 years from now, the prescribed open date. Each grade level will contribute something to the capsule, and this Friday morning in the school hall, we'll hold a small time capsule ceremony to celebrate our past and look toward our future.

The 2013-14 CTY Talent Search sponsored by Johns Hopkins University Center for Talented Youth is underway. The purpose of the Talent Search is to identify, assess and recognize the academic abilities of highly capable students. To qualify, a student must score in the 95th percentile or higher on a subtest of a nationally-normed test, such as ITBS. Qualified students are offered the opportunity to register for the SCAT test (grades 2-6) or for the SAT or ACT (grades 7-8). A variety of services and opportunities are offered to students after they test. If you are interested in pursuing this opportunity for your child, more information can be found by visiting the website: www.cty.jhu.edu/talent. You may determine your child's eligibility based upon last year's ITBS scores. If you have any questions, please feel free to contact Mrs. McFaul at mjmcfaul@holyrosaryws.org. Application forms may be obtained in the school office or on-line at the CTY website. There is a cost of \$39 payable to CTY/JHU to register, and additional fees to the testing agency.
