Dear Holy Rosary Community,

This is a letter from Junior Troop 40699 regarding our work towards our Girl Scout Bronze award. One of our tasks was to look at Energy Conservation in our school. During the winter, we did experiments testing temperatures in school classrooms and checking for drafts in doorways and windows. We also did experiments on energy usage and temperature differences with a variety of light bulbs. We found in our school that there are many different drafts and some extreme temperature differences in classrooms and around the school. At 6:30PM during a winter night, KA room was 80.5 F but by the East Kindergarten ex door it was 57.5 F. Classroom 7A was 77 F and inside the main front door the temperature was 61.5 F. We suggest that the school replace weather stripping on all the doors and check caulk on all windows and doors. A couple of other suggestions are to check the rooms for proper insulation and have the boiler or furnace checked for efficiency. These changes could save the school money and help conserve energy. We suggest every family take the time to check for drafts and temperature differences in their homes, too. During our experiments we found that fluorescent light bulbs also used less electricity and produced less heat. We hope these facts will help you and our school.
