Principal Report – Michael Cantu

Mr. Cantu discussed the changes with after school care at Holy Rosary. B.A.S.E improvements include staff phones, discussion to wire the gym for internet access, and the hiring of two new staff members.

Mr. Cantu discussed upcoming Parent Teacher Conferences and principal and teacher participation in staff retreats.
